

# PUBLIC ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION

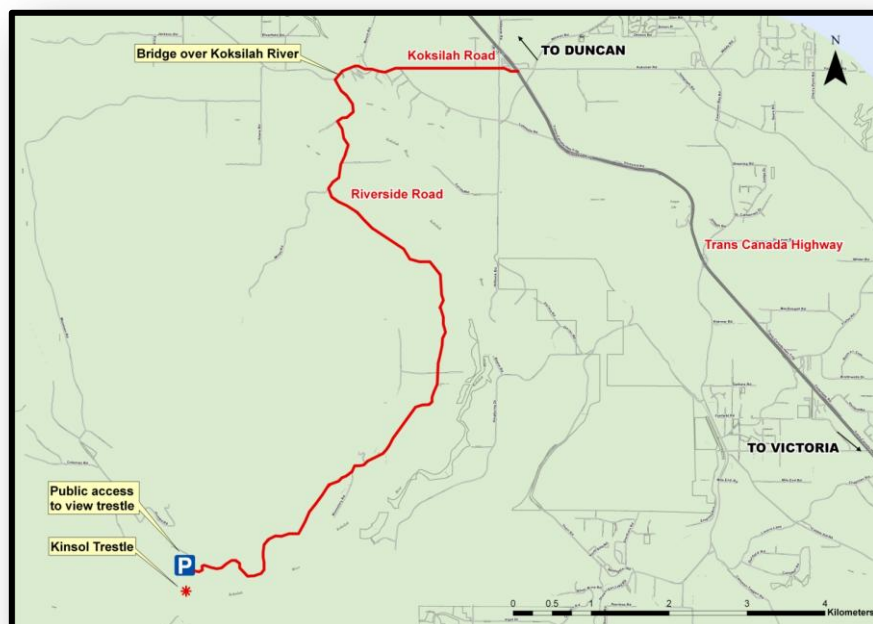
The Cowichan Valley Regional District and its funding partners are excited that work to rehabilitate and open the historic Kinsol Trestle to the public is now underway!

Unfortunately, access to the trestle site from the South end (Glen Eagles Road/Renfrew Road in Shawnigan Lake) is closed to the public for safety reasons due to ongoing construction activities for the duration of the project. Expected opening is Spring 2011.

However, a public viewing area is established at the North end overlooking the trestle with great views of the rehabilitation work underway. See map and directions below.
